

MEDICAL / TRAVEL INSURANCE

Most students are not entitled to publicly funded health services while in New Zelaland unless they are:

- A resident or citizen of Australia or
- · A National of the United Kingdom in New Zeland or
- The holder of a temporary permit that is valid for two years or more.

If you do not belong to one of these special categories and you receive medical treatment during your visit, you will be liable for the cost of that treatment. You must have insurance that will cover the cost of medical treatment in New Zeland for the duration of your stay in New Zealand.

Morrinsville Intermediate School requires students to obtain medical and travel insurance. The school can make suitable recommendations.

Students on a group visit will have medical and travel insurance arranged by the company organising their exchange. A copy of this will be required in English.

IMMIGRATION REQUIREMENTS

Morrinsville Intermediate School:

- Verifies the validity of all international students' visas / permits upon arrival.
- Keeps records of all original visas / permits (including a photocopy of the title page of the students passport).
- Will follow NZ Immigration guidelines if a student is found not to hold a valid student visa / permit, or if a student has terminated their study before course completion.
