

Morrinsville Intermediate Notice – Makuhari Student Hosting Information

We are currently asking families to consider hosting a Japanese student as part of an annual exchange

Every year our school is one of a number in the Waikato area which hosts visiting students from Japan when they stay in New Zealand during March. They will be arriving on **Saturday 9th March and departing Thursday 21st March**. The exchange between the two schools has been an annual event for a number of years and some of our Year 8 students will be returning the visit to Makuhari, Japan, at the end of the third term. It is expected that if your child would like to be considered for the Japanese exchange that your family will host a student.

This is an excellent opportunity to take part in a cultural exchange and for your child to make friends with a student from a very different culture from our own. The costs of hosting a student are reimbursed through a hosting grant of \$335 and there should be no signifiant cost to any family taking up the opportunity to host a student. The Homestay Application Form is on the back of this notice and additional forms are available from the school office.

This year there are 18 Japanese students coming to our school (12 boys and 6 girls who are all 15 years of age). Generally they have a wide range of ability to converse in English, but they have Japanese-English Dictionaries and apps on their phones so comminucation is usually not a problem.

During school days while they are in New Zealand, the Japanese students come to school each day with your child and they will be involved in either a programme here at school or "outside" activities arranged by the tour company. They will be with you each evening and during the two weekends of their stay. Although there is no obligation to spend money entertaining your visitor during the weekends, most families take the opportunity to plan something interesting or special for their guest eg: a trip to a farm or the beach, a bush walk etc.

Host families are asked to supply a cut lunch for their visitors each day. Sometimes the Japanese students return from their excursions late in the afternoon and will need to be collected from school. During the days spent at school students being hosted by families on bus runs are able to arrange for their visitors to travel to and from school on the bus.
